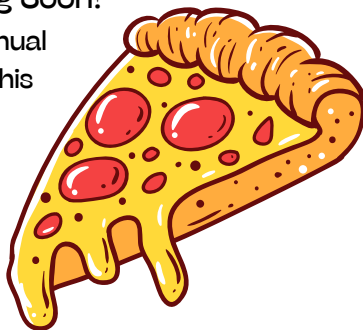

- Please Note: If your child is enrolled in the Before/After Camp Program, you will need to provide breakfast for them. Breakfast is served around 8:00 AM each day.
